## What is the Rental Assistance Program?

The rental assistance program is a financial assistance program that is available to individuals or families who are behind on rental payments due to loss of income related to COVID-19.

Financial assistance is available to those who qualify and may cover expenses such as rental payments, utilities, and housing deposits from April 2020 through December 2020.

## Qualifications:

- Reside in the City of San Jose
- Income loss/reduction due to COVID-19
- Not currently receiving Section 8
- Income at or below 60% of Santa Clara County's AMI (Average Median Income) - to be determined by Housing Staff
- Not subject to lifetime registration requirement under ANY state's sex offender program/registry
- No convictions (within last 3 years) of drug-related criminal activity for the production or manufacture of methamphetamines
